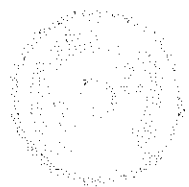

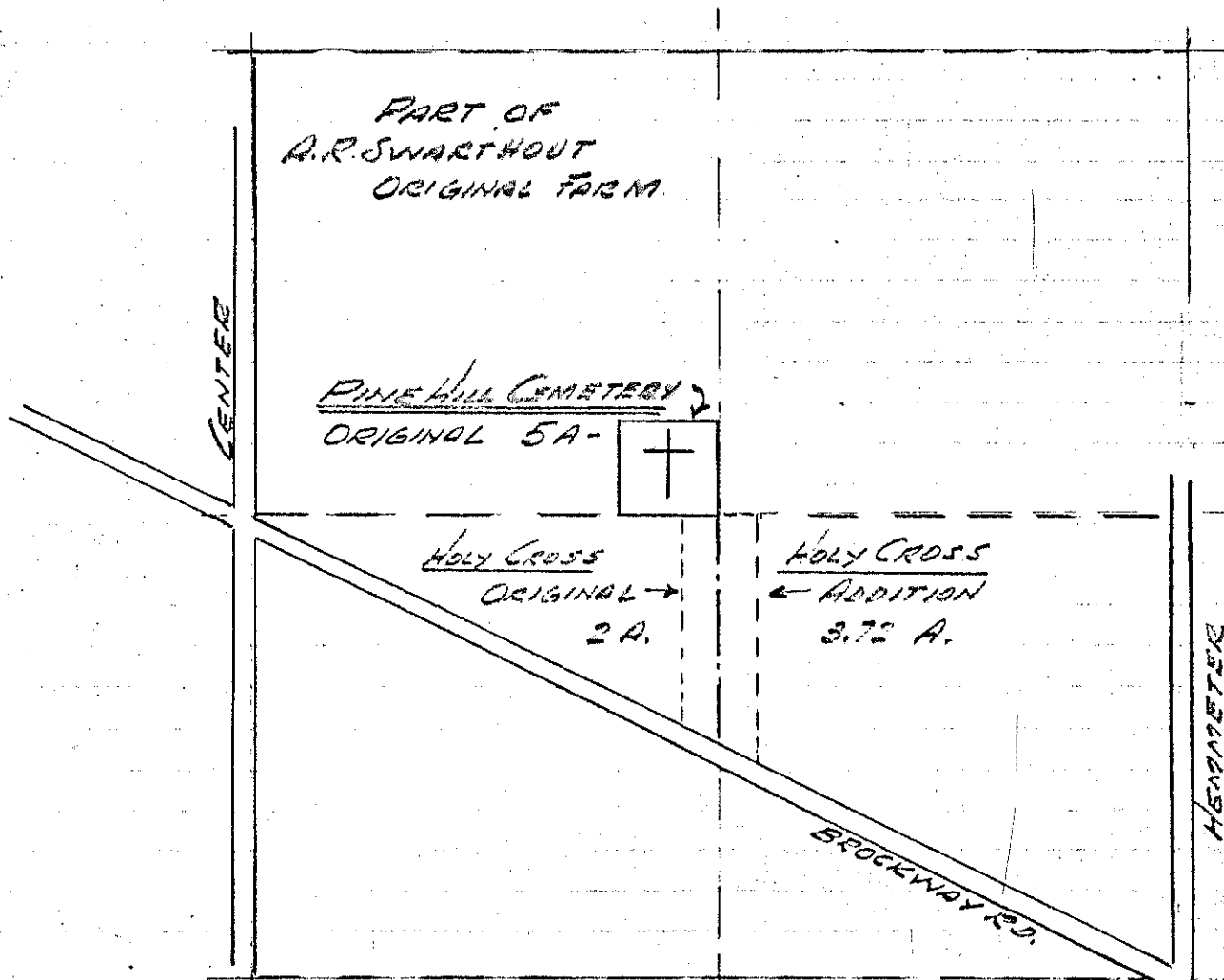

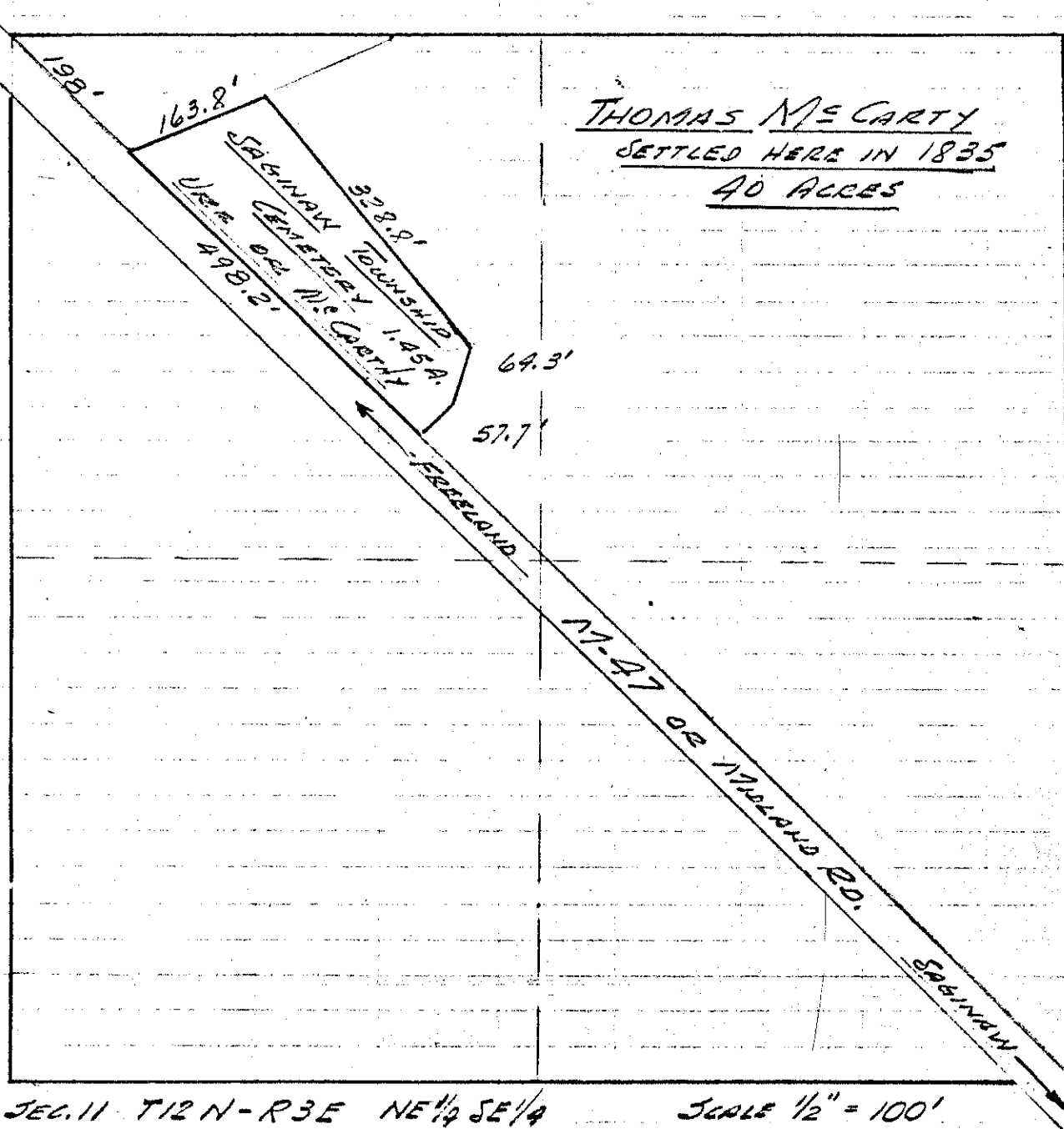

McCARTY, now called SAGINAW TOWNSHIP CEMETERY

Located on Freeland/Midland Road and recorded on Land Records in Saginaw County as T12N R3E Section 11. Acres: 1.45

The markers in this cemetery were read 10 November 1969 by Ruth Fisk ZORN and Lenard S ZORN. Reference is made to a marker: 4 children of H D ROGERS and his wife Rebecca, who died 1859.

In a biographical sketch of Lewis ROGERS¹ it states that his mother, Rebecca, wife of Henry D ROGERS, had 14 children, four born at one time and died in the same month as born.

Therefore, the four children of Henry D ROGERS and his wife Rebecca, were quadruplets, known now as the first quads born in Saginaw County, Michigan, 1859 and died 1859, before they were one month old.

H D ROGERS was township clerk of Tittabawassee in 1855 and in 1860; he also served as treasurer of Tittabawassee Township for the year of 1857².

SAGINAW TOWNSHIP CEMETERY INSCRIPTIONS

This cemetery, also referred to as McCARTY or URE Cemetery, is located in Section 11, Saginaw Township, Saginaw County, Michigan. (Town 12 North - Range 3 East) in the NE¼ of the SE¼ of the NW corner (on M-47) - 1.45 acres.

This pioneer family cemetery is in the 40-acre plat that Thomas McCARTY, at the age of 17, helped his father, Edward, farm. They came from Boston and settled here in August 1830, in Section 11 of what is now Saginaw Township. Thomas McCARTY was supervisor in Tittabawassee Township in 1842-43 and 1853; he also served as the first clerk in 1841. The cemetery was in Tittabawassee Township until 1855 when it became part of Thomas Township. In 1857, Saginaw Township traded land on the west side of the Tittabawassee Road between Hospital Road and the River, which included this cemetery.

At present, the oldest marker is dated 13 April 1850 - George W HARRIS, age 33. The last burial was 27 Nov 1901, that of Elijah BATCHELOR, single and the son of Charles and Mary A (HARRIS) BATCHELOR, who came here from Ohio about 1849. He was 56 at his death. One marker, dated 27 June 1859, indicates four children of Henry D and Rebecca ROGERS who came here in 1849 from New York State. Henry D ROGERS was the Township Clerk in Tittabawassee Township in 1855. Hezekiah TRICKEY, who passed away on 14 Oct 1856, at the age of 44, came here with his wife, Sarah, from New York State in 1846. Many members of pioneer families who settled along the Tittabawassee River in this area, such as ALDRICH, ANDERSON, BRALEY, COLE, McLEAN, PORTER, VanDUESEN and WILTSE, have their final resting place in this hillside cemetery.

Only one burial in this cemetery, that of Elijah BATCHELOR, is on record in the Saginaw County Clerk's office, or in the Michigan Department of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics, Lansing Michigan. The following is the only record of burials in this cemetery.

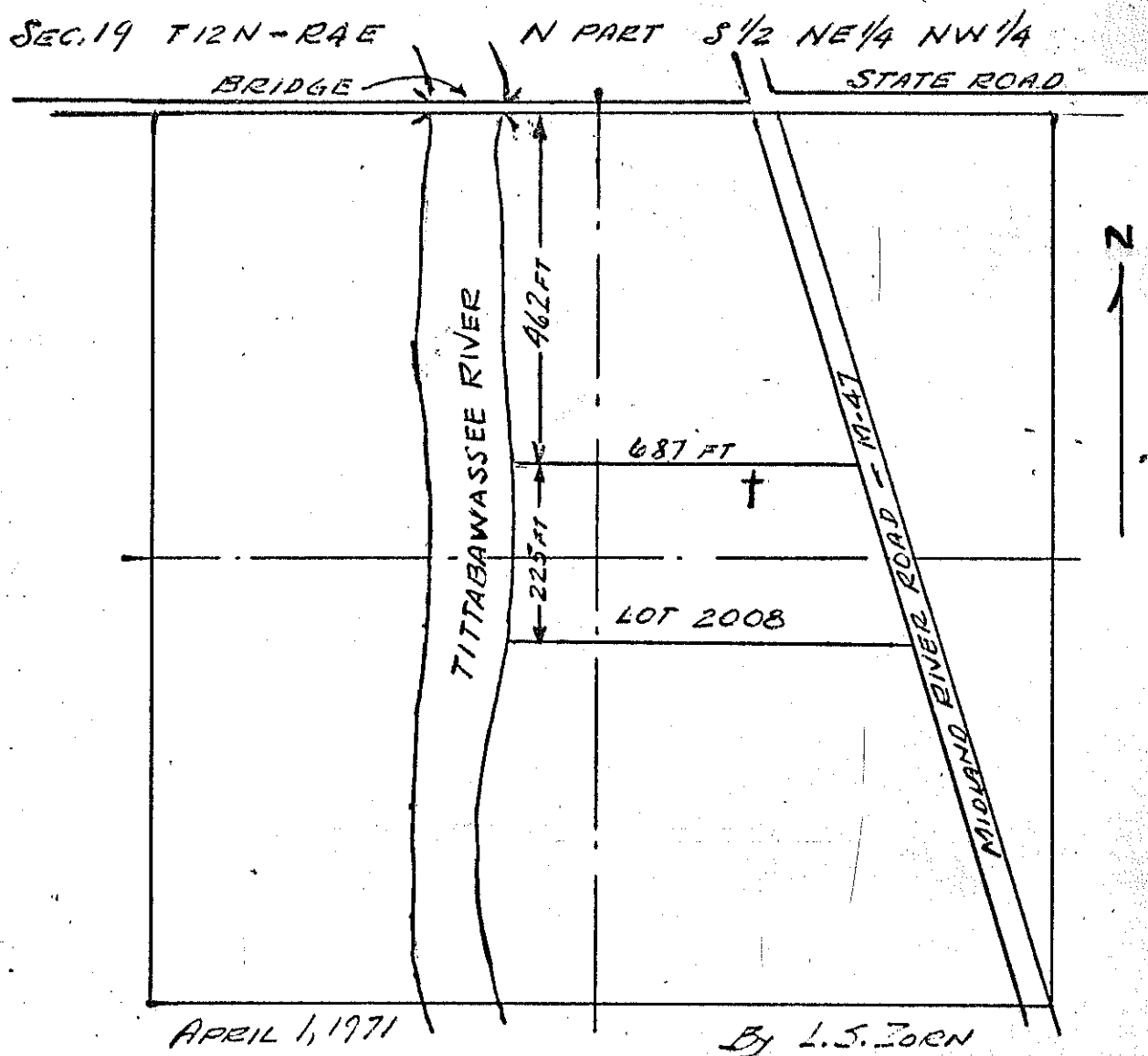

Signed: Amanda L LILLEY: two witnesses sealed (U S Revenue Stamps, \$1.00) Acknowledged in Saginaw County Michigan before William M MILLER, a Notary Public.

In the Register of Deeds office, Saginaw Michigan Liber 68, page 182 is recorded a Sheriff's Deed dated 15 Nov 1873, acknowledged 21 Nov 1873, and recorded 16 Nov 1874, in which Thomas PARKER, by Francisco P WOODRUFF, Deputy Sheriff in and for Saginaw County Michigan conveys to Amanda LILLY of Saginaw County Michigan the equal $\frac{2}{3}$ part of description in Liber 33 - page 478, as stated above. Consideration: \$213.10.

NOTE: Amy H henry was the wife of Abraham WHITNEY. Amanda LILLY wife of J J LILLY, was the daughter of Abraham and Amy WHITNEY.

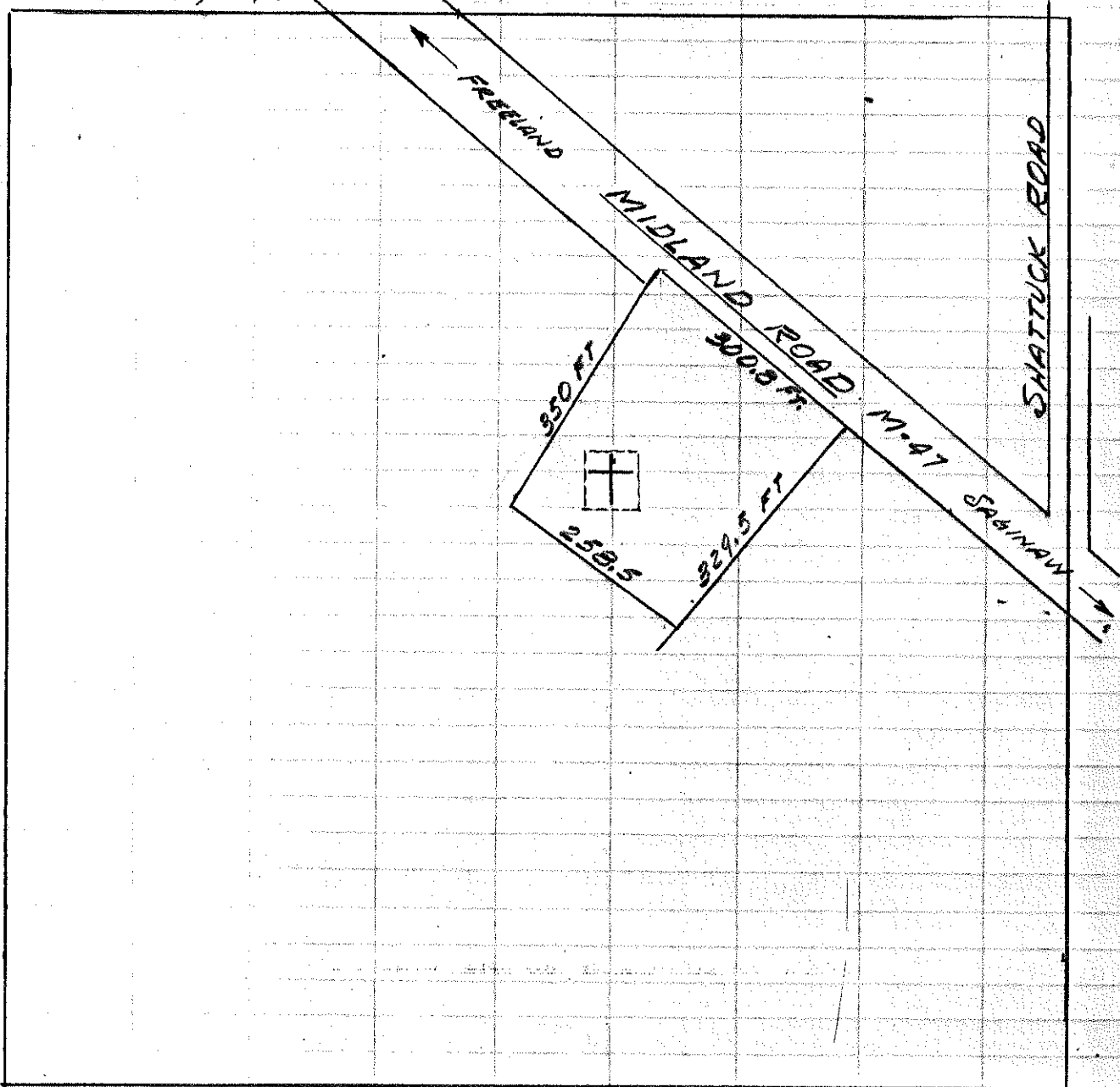

BRALEY FAMILY CEMETERY

This is now on private property owned by C H STOLTZ and Marjorie STOLTZ at 2965 Midland Road, Rte #6 - 2.14 acres, listed in Saginaw Township Assessment Books (1970) - Book I, page 30. The site of the cemetery has been obliterated; the markers have been laid flat and are covered with lawn. The burials are all under the rear lawn. The HUBBARD family located on fractional N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, south of the BRALEY property. Later on the HUBBARD property became part of the G W and A W BACON farm.

THE OLD LUTHERAN CEMETERY
Gladwin County, Michigan

Located on Tittabawassee Hill, on the west bank of the Tittabawassee River, Section 28, Secord Township.

This cemetery is about 500 feet north of Ridge Road on the east side of the Sugar River. it is all fenced, but badly neglected.

At one time there was a Lutheran Church located near the cemetery. it was organized about 1910, but the building moved to a new location on the corner of Three Rivers and Secord Dam Roads about 1936.

The land was donated to the church by Herman Ripke and he was buried here, but later moved to a cemetery in Midland. The land reverted to the Ripke family after the church was dissolved. The cemetery is thick underbrush and trees.

It is reported that several BENKE children were buried here, and a child of Albert LANG buried here about 1919.
